



TATERS Consulting Teacher of Special Education Endorsement Program

Sequence of Courses

Beginning in Summer 2010, the Department of Special Education at BSU is offering a cohort of four graduate level courses that lead to a recommendation to receive the Consulting Teacher Endorsement from the Idaho State Department of Education. To accommodate teachers who do not live within physical access of BSU, we have developed a program of four courses - three online courses, and one summer academy (a week long course in the beginning of the summer), with lodging and meals provided at no additional cost to the student.

This program is geared towards special education teachers with current certificates who have been teaching a minimum of 2 years. Districts may use Title 1 & Title IIA professional development funds to support teacher's tuition and fees.

Students who begin work on the endorsement in Summer 2010 are able to be recommended for this endorsement as early as May 2011. Additionally, the courses can also be used towards attainment of a Master of Education degree when other additional Graduate Program requirements are met.
